In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Andamans and Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Tax Regulation 1940 (Regulation No. VIII of 1940), the Chief Commissioner, A & N Islands has been pleased to make the following amendment in the A & N Motor Vehicles Tax Rules, 1940, issued vide Administration's Notification No. 15 of 1951 dated 23rd January, 1951 namely:-

Amendment.

In the said Rules, in rule 23 after sub-rule (4), the following sub-rule shall be inserted namely:-

"(5) A Motor Vehicle in respect of which road tax has not been paid or even after the grace period allowed under rule 21 shall be liable to be seized by a Police Officer, not below the rank of Head Constable. On such seizure the vehicle seized shall be forthwith sent to the Court of the Magistrate having jurisdiction to try the offences under the Regulation. When a Motor Vehicle is produced in Court under this clause the Court shall not release the vehicle unless and until the entire arrears of road tax in respect of the vehicle are paid".

No. 54/76/45-45/75-TR.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 91 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (Central Act 4 of 1939), read with the notification No. 26-T (1)/57 dated the 25th April, 1957 of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Transport (Transport Wing), New Delhi, the Chief Commissioner, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following amendment to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Rules 1939, the same having been previously published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette Extraordinary No. 4 dated the 17th January, 1976 under the Administration's notification No. 7/76/45-45/75-TR of the same date, as required by Section 133(1) of the said Act and directs that amendment shall take effect from 1st April, 1976, namely:—

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, after Rule 206, the following rule shall be added, namely:—

" 207. Crash helmets to be worn : No person, excepting the one wearing Turban, shall drive a Motor Cycle or a Scooter in any public place unless the person so driving wears a crash helmet. "
